



Illustrated C# For Beginners



Course Description

Illustrated C # for beginners is an interactive, Adobe flash based self-paced tutorial providing a complete introduction to the Microsoft C sharp programming language. This tutorial is suited for beginning programmers or anyone who would like to gain familiarity with the Microsoft C# programming language. These tutorial lessons will help you get a quick head-start with C# programming.

The tutorial consists of several lessons explaining in simple and easy-to-follow terms. Numerous examples are used to demonstrate every step in the learning process.

This will also greatly helps students in preparing for Microsoft Certification Exams.



Course Prerequisites

Although no programming experience is needed, one should be comfortable working within the Windows operating system environment. The course material should be understandable to anyone aged 15 and up.

To get started, you will need a Microsoft Visual Studio .NET compiler and a text editor. This is a separate **FREE** Microsoft product that must be obtained from Microsoft. It is available for download at Microsoft website -

You should download and install both Visual C# Express and the MSDN Library (help files). Apart from this no other resources are needed to learn this industry standard programming language.



System requirements

Windows 2000 or higher
CPU 800 MHz or above.
64MB memory.
At least 180MB hard disk space.



Installation

Installation process is simple and straight forward. Begin the Installation process by double clicking on the setup file. The installation requires about 20 megabytes of disk space for **demo** and 170 megabytes of disk space for full version.

To work with the sample codes, use Visual C# Express as the IDE (Integrated Development Environment) for building and testing C# applications.



How to Take the Course

This is a self-paced course. The suggested approach is to do one class a day for 40 days. Each day's class should require about 15 to 30 minutes watching the video and about 1 hour doing examples in Visual Studio. In order to grasp the concepts completely, we suggest you to refer to the built in MSDN library for up to date information on the topic.

Try to do each example as they are encountered in the notes.
